



CHEMICAL SPLASH/BURN ACTION PLAN

DANGER

Ensure that the area is safe for yourself, others and the injured
Students **SHOULD** call the attention of any Departmental staff



RESPONSE

Immediately **ALERT** the Block Coordinator or Supervisor

SEND for the first aid provider, if possible

REMOVE quickly any contaminated pieces of:

clothing, watches, jewelry, contact lens, etc. as applicable

For dry chemicals, **BRUSH OFF** as much powder as possible

For chemical splash to the eyes, lead the injured

USE the sink, eye wash or emergency shower as applicable

RINSE immediately with chemical/eye flush,

if available, to neutralize/dilute any chemicals on the affected area:

Minimum: 15 minutes, Maximum: 30 minutes

FLUSH further the affected area with running water:

Minimum: 15 minutes, Maximum: 60 minutes

APPLY an antiseptic ointment

WRAP with sterilized gauze around the burn



SEND for help

IF pain continues or resumes

IF injured insists in going to the clinic

IF chemical splash is highly toxic

FOLLOW the rule of nines (for burns)

SEEK medical assistance by calling **9999**

BRING the MSDS to be provided to the attending doctor



CONFINE any minor spill that occurred



EVACUATE the area if major spill

PROVIDE an incident report
